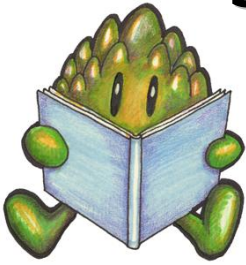

#### **Journal Article with Continuous Pagination** (MLA 5.7.1) (Continuous pagination means that pages are numbered continuously throughout each annual volume; if the first issue ends on page 174, the first page of the second issue will be 175. This example is from the 19<sup>th</sup> issue of volume 294.)

#### **Journal Article with Issues Paged Separately** (MLA 5.7.2) (Each issue begins on page 1. This example is from the 4<sup>th</sup> issue of volume 50.)
