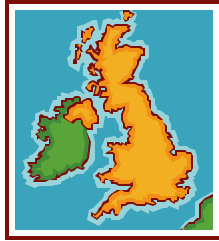
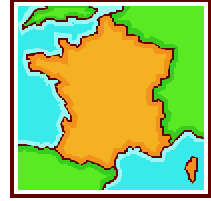


London/Paris Education Abroad Program



"Opening the Mind" Scholarships Available



For SCC's London/Paris
Education Abroad Program
May 16 - 29, 2008

Background Information: In an effort to support Education Abroad programs and 'opening the mind' to international experiences for SCC students, the International Education Programs Office at SCC provides limited funds to eligible and accepted participants of its District-approved Education Abroad courses. When granted, these funds are applied toward program costs only and are dependent upon the funding currently available. For summer 2008, the London/Paris Education Abroad Program scholarships are awards of at least \$700.

Eligibility: You must be a current SCC student who has taken at least 12-15 credits at SCC with a minimum 2.5 gpa at the time of application. (Please submit an unofficial transcript from the colleges/universities you've attended in the past 10 years.)

Award Responsibility:

- ✧ Successfully complete course
- ✧ Contribute to SCC's future education abroad programs by completing one of the following activities:
 - Write an article for the Global Artichoke Newsletter
 - Write an article for the Campus News newspaper
 - Volunteer at the Education Abroad Resource Tables during International Education Week (third week in November)
 - A project that is agreed upon between Ed Abroad Advisor and student

Procedure: Fill out the application form below and submit it to the International Education Programs Office by

February 29, 2008

The IEP Office will inform you of the decision by March 21, 2008. You may also be eligible for Federal Financial Aid for education abroad. Please check with the Financial Aid Office for eligibility and the financial aid application form.
