ON SEPARATE PAPER!

- 1) Redo every part of a problem with missed points; not just the error the whole part.
- 2) After each mathematical correction, write a short paragraph discussing the following:
 - The error made and what you were thinking about that problem during the exam
 - What you did to correct the error and what new thinking you should engage in for future exams
 - What you learned overall after looking at your error and making the corrections

Take this seriously – this work will be graded for accuracy in the mathematics and concise writing.

You may receive less than full credit if errors are found or writing is not clear and precise.

Do not use the tutor center, classmates, other tutors or other instructors to help with your corrections.

You may use your text and/or notes for help.

Before turning them in you may bring them to Miss Dueck for her to check if you want to ensure full credit. You must do this before the day they are due.
