Scottsdale Community College offers a Certificate of Completion in Fire Operations. The certificate provides the opportunity for sponsored and non-sponsored students to acquire a Firefighter I & II certificate in a college-based Fire Academy.

Prerequisites for FSC102 (Fire Academy Class):

- Successful completion of EMT104 with a grade of "B" or better ---
---OR --- current AZ State EMT-B – or EMT-Paramedic Certification
- Current CPR Certification at the Healthcare Provider Level.
- Successful completion of FSC105: Hazardous Materials/First Responder ---
---OR --- Hazardous Materials/First Responder Certificate
- Completion of FSC130: Fitness & Conditioning/CPAT with a passing grade within 6 months prior to acceptance ---
--- OR --- current passed CPAT within 6 months prior to the 1st day of class.

Co-requisite for FSC102: (To be taken in conjunction with FSC 102)

FSC134: Fitness & Conditioning/Firefighters (3 credits) Serves as physical training and health/wellness education to enhance the academy experience.

FSC102: Firefighting Operations (Fire Academy) is a total educational experience covering aspects of firefighting procedures and techniques. On completion of the SCC Fire Academy (with a letter grade of "B" or better) the graduate is eligible to sit for the Firefighter I & II state exam.

It is essential that Fire Academy students be able to perform a number of physical activities in the lab portion of the academy. At a minimum, students will be required to lift heavy equipment, stand several hours at a time and perform bending activities. The lab experience also places students under considerable mental and emotional stress as they undertake responsibilities and duties in firefighting. Individuals should give careful consideration to mental and physical demands of the program prior to applying.
