<b>Complete Maricopa Prerequisites</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>BIO156 or 181 or 1 year of High School Biology</li><li>BIO201</li><li>CHM130AA or 1 year of High School Chemistry</li><li>ENG101</li><li>MAT141 or higher</li></ul>	<i>Nursing students must submit a final H.S. transcript to prove completion of HS BIO and HS Chem. If you are using coursework from any other College/University to meet Prerequisites, you must request official transcripts be sent directly from that college(s) to SCC. Grades must be C or higher.</i>
<b>Obtain Level 1 Fingerprint Clearance</b>	<i>This process can take up to 4-6 weeks.</i>
<b>*Complete NUR158 or Equivalent Nurse Assisting course OR Provide proof of a CNA certification or Licensure (Does not need to be active.)</b>	<i>NUR158 is offered in Fall &amp; Spring. Please note: A fingerprint clearance card and other documentation is required prior to registration.</i> <b>*Requirement pause from July 1, 2025 - June 30, 2026. CNA will not be required during this period.</b>
<b>Complete HESI – A2 Entrance Exam with minimum scores met</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Math (min score 75%) _____</li><li>English Composite (min score 80%) _____</li></ul>	<i>There is a review book, online resources, and review sessions at other Maricopa campuses</i>
<b>Apply to the Traditional RN program</b>	<i>Traditional RN application must be submitted prior to CEP application.</i>
