BPC110 Computer Usage and Applications (3 credits) - OR -	Provides an introduction to business and personal computer operations and usage.
CIS105 Survey of Computer Information Systems (3 credits)	Overview of computer technology, concepts, terminology, and the role of computers in business and society.
GBS120 Workplace Communication Skills (3 credits)	Introduction to business and personal computer operations and usage. Software applications include word processing, spreadsheet, database, and presentation graphics.
GBS151 Introduction to Business (3 credits)	Characteristics and activities of current business including marketing, management, and finance.
MGT101 Techniques of Supervision (3 credits) - OR -	Overview of the foundations of supervision and how to get things done within an organization through other people.
MGT229 Management and Leadership I (3 credits)	Covers management concepts and applications for business, industry, and government organizations.
MGT175 Business Organization and Management (3 credits)	Covers basic principles of managing quality and performance in organizations. Covers management functions: planning, organizing, leading, and controlling. Emphasizes continual improvement, ethics, and social responsibility.
MGT251 Human Relations in Business (3 credits)	Analysis of motivation, leadership, communications, and other human factors or cultural differences that may create conflict and affect morale individually and within organizations.
