

### Eligible students must:

- Be currently enrolled at Scottsdale Community College
- Enroll in 6 or more credits (part-time or full-time)
- Belong to a federally or state-recognized Tribe or a Canadian First Nation
- Reside in Arizona and meet in-state residency requirements

- Maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA
- Complete the FAFSA and meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)
- Pursue a financial aid-eligible degree or certificate
- Note: Students already receiving a Maricopa Grant through financial aid are not eligible

### APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- Proof of tribal enrollment (Tribal ID, CIB, or Treaty Card)
- Class schedule
- Degree plan or academic advisement report
- Unofficial transcript
- Responses to 3–5 short essay questions

# AWARD INFORMATION

- Award amounts vary depending on available funding
- Recipients will be notified via email by the American Indian Program Office
- Funds are disbursed through SCC's Financial Aid Office
- Students may reapply each academic year

# WHAT'S EXPECTED OF RECIPIENTS

To remain eligible throughout the semester:

- Complete an AIP
   Scholarship Expectations

  Form at the start of each term
- Attend a minimum of three AIP or SCCsponsored events or workshops
- Check in with AIP Staff three times per semester for support and progress
- Submit required reflections & participation documention

### **CONTINUED ELIGIBILITY**

To renew or reapply, recipients should:

- Remain in good academic standing
- Fulfill participation and documentation requirements each term
- Notify AIP of any changes to enrollment status
