Thank you for your interest in the post-baccalaureate teacher certification program that is offered at Scottsdale Community College. Scottsdale Teacher Education Partnership (STEP) is a field-based immersion program where students learn alongside master teachers for a full year. This teacher-in-training program is based on the conviction that future teachers must have lengthy experience in schools to practice what they are learning in college. Students complete the program as a cohort, and are required to commit to the program for the full year.

Courses meet on Wednesday and Thursday evenings from 5:00 – 8:30 PM. The courses are a blend of face-to-face and on-line learning. The cohort begins in November and ends the following December.

Beginning in January, students spend two consecutive full days at schools working side-by-side with teachers in classrooms (usually 7:30 AM – 3:00 PM) and attend classes at SCC from 5:00 – 8:30 PM on Wednesdays and Thursdays. Homework and class preparation are in addition to these hours.

Many candidates substitute teach on the days they are not interning in the classroom. Teacher in Residence candidates intern in their own classrooms.

During the summer session beginning in mid-May and ending in July, students will be completing only courses.

At the beginning of August, students will resume interning and will also be completing course work until mid-October. Student teaching will begin in mid-October. Students will be working full time, five days per week for twelve weeks at a school student teaching. No courses are taken during this time.

This application packet contains the following information:

When the complete application is submitted and a student is determined eligible for the program, an interview will be scheduled as the final part of the application process.

Candidates will receive an email indicating acceptance into the program.

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Transcripts
