WEEKLY TIME COMMITMENT

On average, each 1-credit hour of a class requires 45 total hours of time commitment, regardless of the modality or number of weeks the class is offered. The time commitment includes any scheduled meeting times as well as assignment work and study time. The table to the right shows the average weekly time commitment based on credit hours and length of a class.
