DETAILS

- All classes meet the Pharmacy Technician Certification Board (PTCB) requirements
- Program is 16 credits and will prepare you to take the Pharmacy Technician Certification Exam (PTCE) or the National Healthcareer Association (NHA) Exam for the Certification of Pharmacy Technicians (ExCPT)
- Total cost to complete the program is approximately \$1500 (not including course materials and health/safety requirements)
- Program includes hands-on learning through a 200-hour externship (apply what you learn in class, in real-world settings!)
- Network with professionals already working in the field
- Classes begin in October
