STEP PROGRAM

May Start | Traditional Cohort

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Thank you for your interest in the post-baccalaureate teacher certification program that is offered at Scottsdale Community College. Scottsdale Teacher Education Partnership (STEP) is a field-based immersion program where students learn alongside master teachers for a full year. This teacher-in-training program is based on the conviction that future teachers must have lengthy experience in schools to practice what they are learning in college. Students complete the program as a cohort, and are required to commit to the program for the full year.

Courses meet on Monday and Tuesday evenings from 4:00 – 8:30 PM. The courses are a blend of face-to-face and on-line learning. The cohort begins in May and ends the following May.

The Summer program will begin in mid-May and end in July. Students will be completing only courses during the summer.

Beginning in August, students spend two consecutive full days at schools working side-by-side with teachers in classrooms (usually 7:30 AM – 3:00 PM) and attend classes at SCC from 4:00 – 8:30 PM on Mondays and Tuesdays. Homework and class preparation are in addition to these hours.

Many candidates substitute teach on the days they are not interning in the classroom.

At the end of the program during student-teaching, students spend five days per week, full time for twelve weeks at the school, with no classes at SCC.

This application packet contains the following information:

2. Application Process which explains the admission requirements and a check-list for completing the application.
3. STEP Application

When the complete application is submitted and a student is determined eligible for the program, an interview will be scheduled as the final part of the application process.

Candidates will receive an email indicating acceptance into the program.

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Transcripts

Transcripts are required to be sent from the University. We are not allowed to accept transcripts from students. When ordering transcripts, choose Scottsdale CC from the list of institutions listed in the drop down.

If you received your degree from an institution outside of the United States, please have your transcript evaluated by an approved Arizona Department of Education transcript evaluation provider.
