

How to Use maricopa.edready.org for Placement


These instructions will help you access the temporary placement substitute for Accuplacer tests for ENG 101, MAT 142, and reading courses. Be sure to have the following items handy before you begin:

1. Your **MEID**
2. Your Maricopa email address (yourMEID@maricopa.edu)—if you have not accessed your Maricopa email account, go to <http://google.maricopa.edu>


Getting Started


If you have an EdReady account, click the **Log In** dropdown menu in the upper right-hand corner to enter your login information.

If you don't have an account:


- Fill in the form (as shown below) under **Sign Up** For EdReady to create an account

- Enter your MEID to complete your account setup
- Once you have entered this information, the system will send an activation email to your Maricopa.edu email address
- Copy and paste the activation code when prompted on the link to activate your EdReady account

When you log in to the homepage, you will see the available placement assessments, as shown below.



To place into ALT 100 or ENG 101, choose EdReady English Placement by clicking the blue Go to Goal button.



To place into MAT 140, 141, or 142, choose Quantitative Reasoning Alg Stats Placement by clicking the blue Go to Goal button.




Quantitative Reasoning Alg and Stats Placement

To place into ALT 100, RDG 081, or RDG 100, choose College Reading Placement by clicking the blue Go to Goal button.




College Reading Placement

To place into or exempt out of CRE 101, choose College Critical Reading and Critical Thinking Placement by clicking the blue Go to Goal button.




Critical Reading and Critical Thinking Placement

Completing the Diagnostic

To start the diagnostic, click on the **Start test now** button, and you will be given a series of questions. It will take about one hour to complete the diagnostic.



College Math Readiness

The first step of your study path is to complete this initial diagnostic to gain an understanding of your readiness.

Answer the questions as best you can, without study aids, in order to get the most accurate picture of your current understanding.

There is no built-in calculator for EdReady. Some exams (e.g., Accuplacer) allow the use of calculators for some problems, but not others. Use your judgment (or ask your teacher) to decide whether it is appropriate to use a calculator for some or all of this initial diagnostic.


The time of completion will vary. Expect to take at least an hour.

If you need to leave before your initial diagnostic is complete, your work will automatically be saved until your next visit to EdReady.


